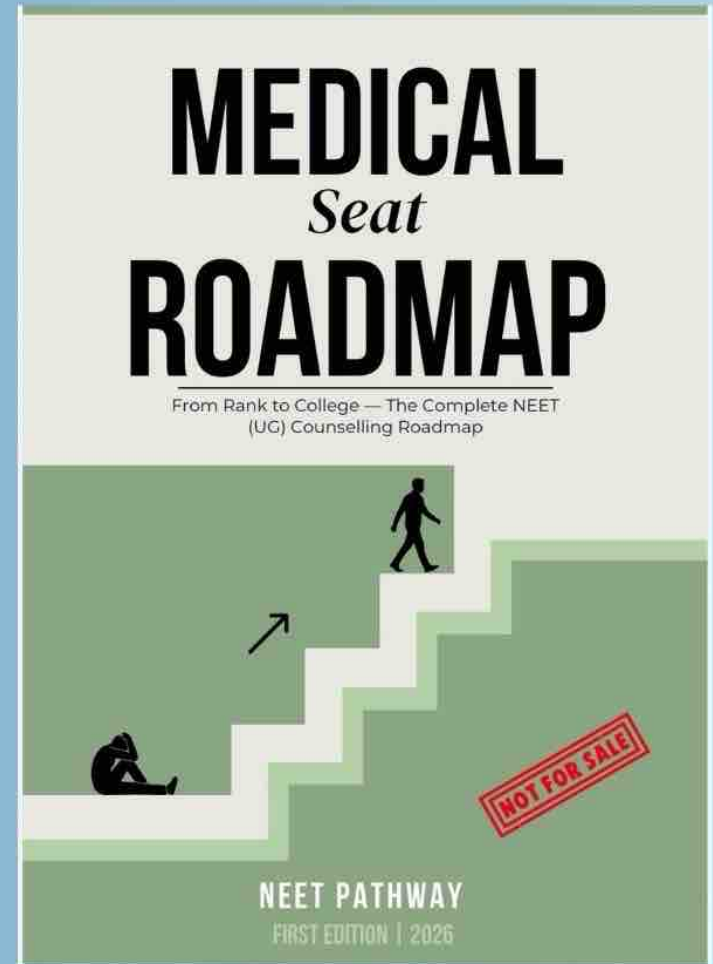

Documents are critically important for HEEET counselling 2026, serving as the final confirmation of the candidate's identity, eligibility, and category, and are essential to secure a seat.

Without valid, original documents (like mark sheets and category certificates), candidates will be disqualified at the initial stage of counselling during verification or at final reporting stage.

Although a slight variation is observed in 2025, the overall trend reflects sustained high participation even increased seats are not enough to reduce competition.

Over the last five years, NEET UG counselling data shows a steady rise in cut-off scores, increased competition due to higher registrations, and greater seat allocation efficiency through centralized counselling systems like MCC and state quotas.

CHOICE FILLING & LOCKING

After fee payment, fill your preferred colleges and courses. You can:

Steps for Choice Filling/Locking

- Visit the official MCC website and select the "UG Medical Counseling" section.
- Log in with your credentials.
- Fill choices and arrange them in order of preference.
- Review the selected colleges.
- Click "Lock Choices" and enter the password to finalize.
- Print the confirmation page/locked choices slip.
- Lock your choices before the deadline. If not locked manually, system auto-locks the last Saved choices

Critical Tips

"A college not on your list will never be allotted."

The system only considers colleges you explicitly add. Even if you have the rank for a top college, it won't be assigned if it's missing from your list.

"Do not rely on auto-lock."

Lock your choices before the deadline. If not locked manually, system auto-locks the last saved choices.

"Order is everything."

The algorithm works from the topdown. If you put a low-tier college above a better one and qualify for both, you will be allotted the lower tier one and cannot go "backwards" to the better option in that round.

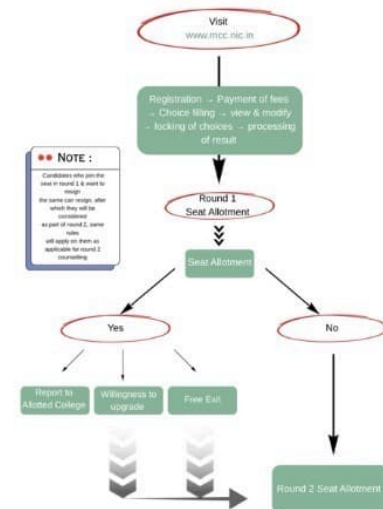

DOWNLOAD SEAT ALLOTMENT LETTER

After each counselling round, seat allotment result are announced on the MCC portal.

If a seat is allotted :

- Steps To Download :**
1. Visit mcc.nic.in
 2. Click UG Medical Counselling
 3. Login using :
 - NEET Roll
 - Number Password
 - Security Pin
 4. Go to Seat Allotment Result
 5. Download the **Seat Allotment Letter**



After every round of counselling, the seat allotment result will be declared. NEET counselling result, released in the form of the allotment list and seat allotment letter, will release the seat allotted to the candidates.

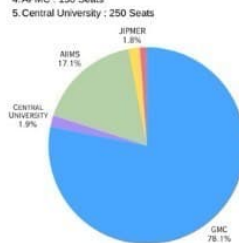

- Students with a lower rank in NEET UG 2025 have a higher probability of getting a seat in these specific states because these states have higher number of seats.
- Those who will undergo counselling for government colleges, in states where government seats are higher, their chances of getting a college are better.

Those whose rank are even lower should do counselling in these 5 states which have the maximum seats.
